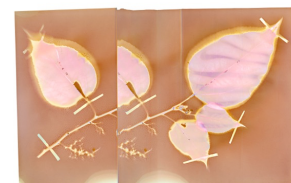

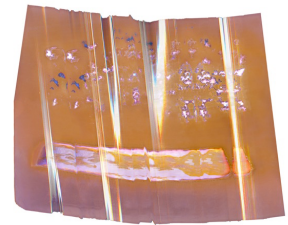
TUUNG (*puri mosiikah/strong headache*), 2016

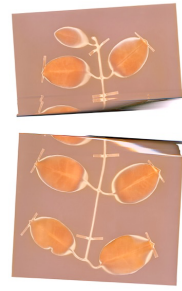
NAAI (*poriyau tawareikoring/skin fungus*), 2016

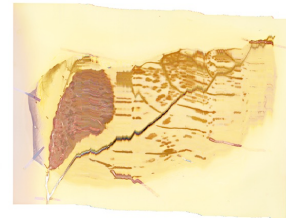
MOI (*kevi mosiikha/toothache*), 2016
